You are in charge of developing and implementing measures leading to knowledge exchange with the NCCR non-academic stakeholders (institutional partners, decision-makers and opinion leaders). You organize events, such as “expert exchange roundtables” and “institutional get-togethers”, for the main stakeholders, those being policy-makers, public administrations, civil society organizations and other institutions and individuals interested in migration and mobility issues. You are responsible for encouraging researchers to author Policy Briefs and blog posts and supporting them during the writing process. A further task is to pursue the development and promotion of the Migration-Mobility Indicators, which means that you coordinate the input from different actors within the NCCR (data, visualizations, texts) and adapt the content of the web platform when new Indicators are ready to be released.

You have an academic education (preferably a doctoral degree) in social sciences with a good knowledge of migration/mobility studies. Ideally, you have experience in the communication of scientific contents to non-academic audiences. You are a proactive individual with good organizational, interpersonal skills, who takes pleasure in interdisciplinary research environments and is committed to creating equal opportunities. You are motivated by the prospect of fostering a continuous dialogue between the NCCR researchers and its external stakeholders to facilitate policy formulation and a sound analysis of the current situation. You have an excellent written and oral command of English, as well as French or German, with a good knowledge of the other language.
