This is a story about a Canadian First Nations girl who triumphs over obstacles in her young life. Her new teacher discovers her extraordinary gifts as a violinist. When Shana goes on a spiritual journey, she befriends a wild wolf who guides her and she reconnects with her ancestors, including her mother. Finally, Shana is able to make peace with her mother's death and, absorbed by nature and the spiritual world, she finds a unique way of musical expression, which allows her to have a career as a violinist.

The screening of the movie as part of the Seminar "Les mobilités humaines dans le cinéma" will be followed by an open discussion with Nino Jacusso, the Italo-Swiss filmmaker, moderated by Gianni D'Amato, the director of the nccr – on the move.
