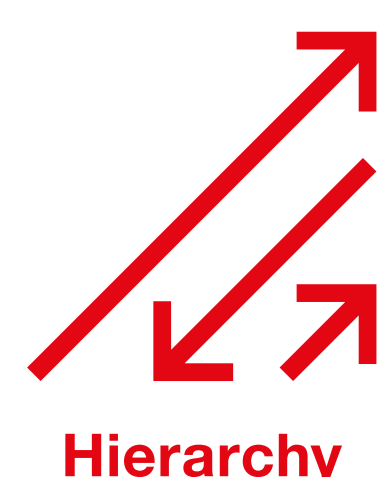


Boost or Blow

Research Questions

How do crises affect the global governance of migration?



Contributions to NCCR

First systematic and theory-driven attempt to study

1. How crises express in discursive and behavioural change in key International Organizations over time
2. How migration diplomats make sense of migration crises and governance
3. How and under what conditions burden-sharing emerges in reaction to crisis

Data

Coded corpus of all statements made in the Executive Committee of UNHCR
2,2 million words

Elite survey: 34 state diplomats' perspectives on international cooperation on migration in International Organizations

Archival research and document collection from UNHCR and IOM

Main Results

Longitudinal perspective to governance through crises

Discourse analysis of central states and organizations

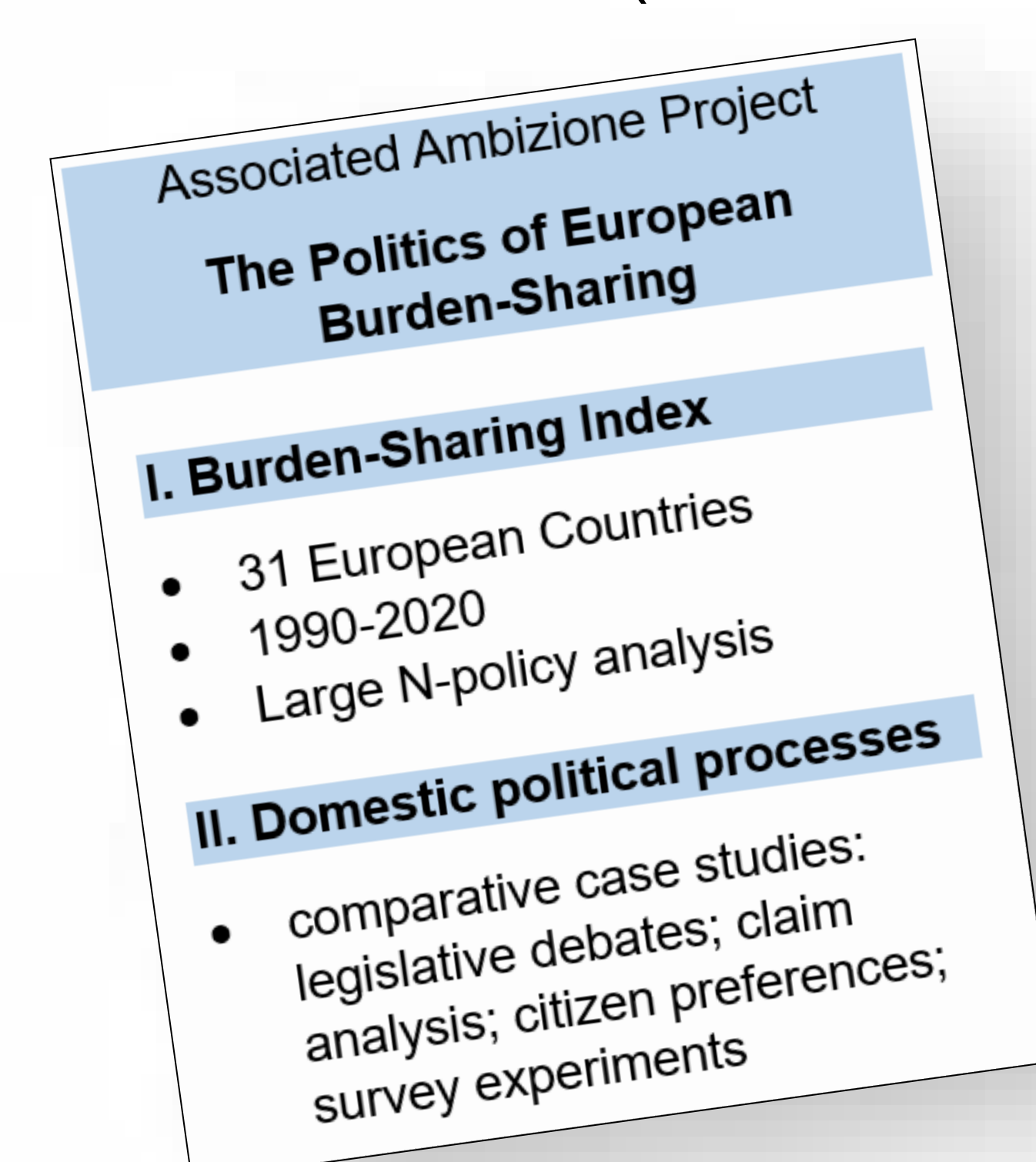
Extensive review of the implementations and effects of the Global Compact on Safe Orderly and Regular Migration

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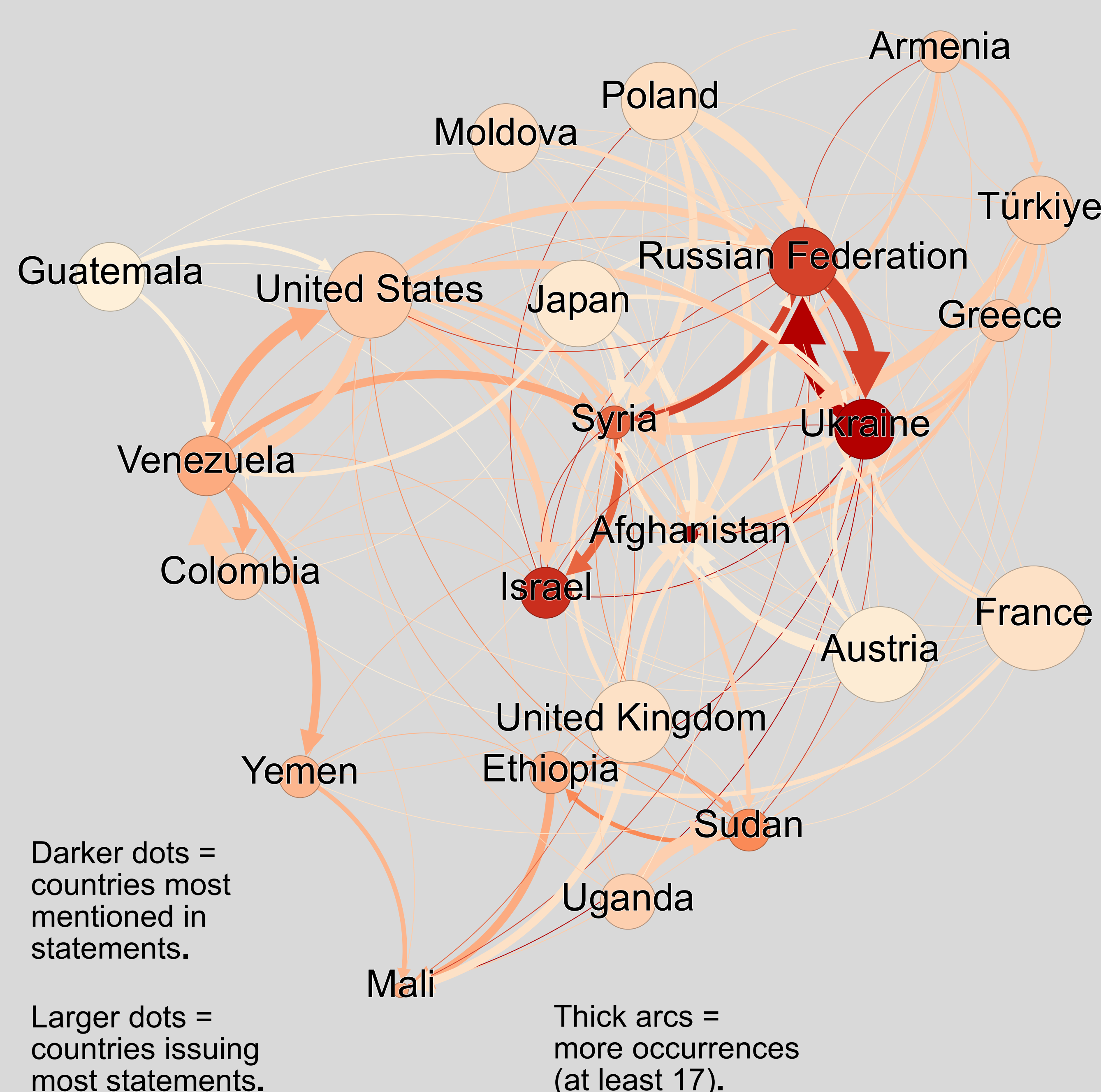
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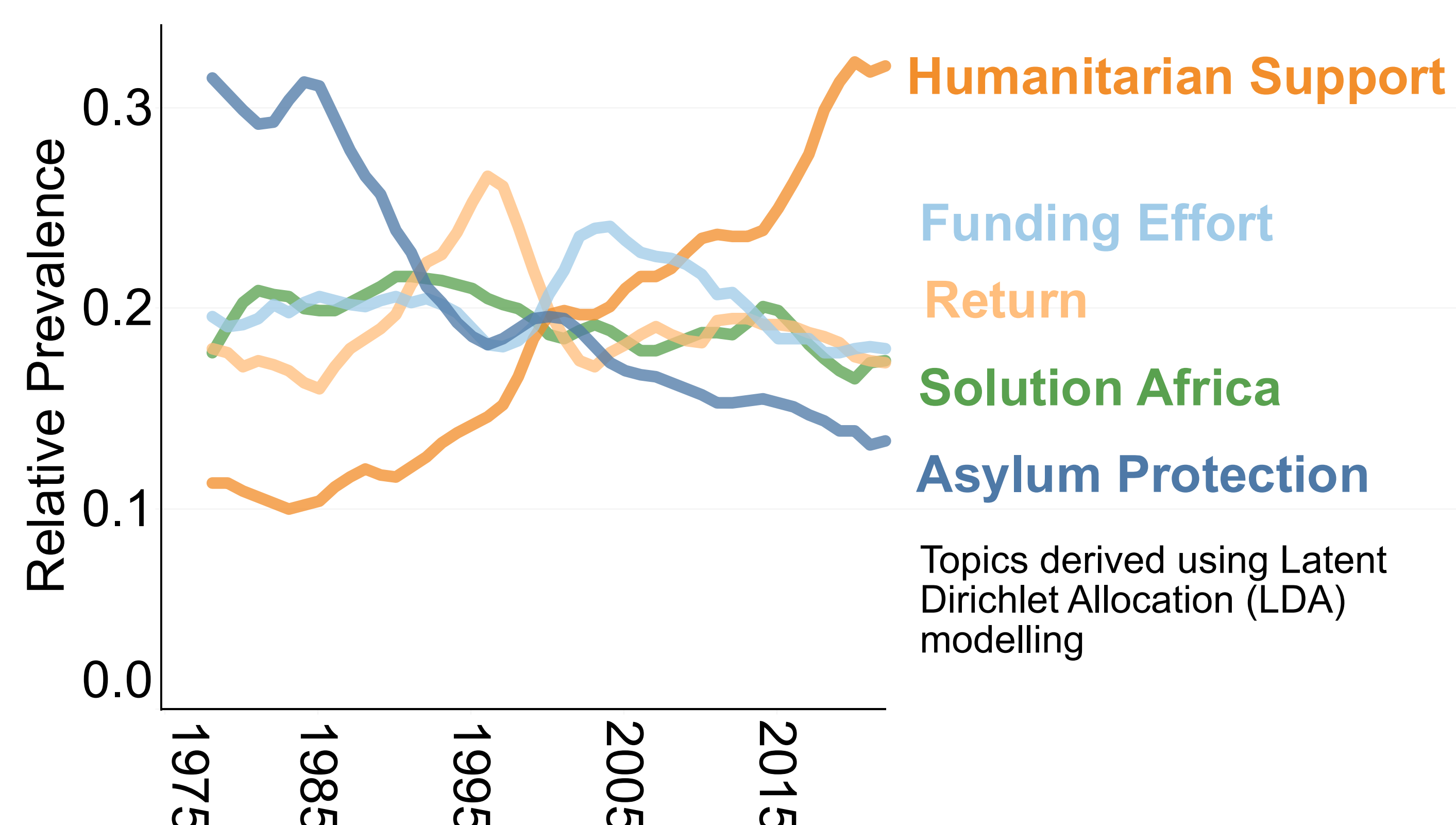


UNHCR Executive Committee Corpus: migration diplomacy systematized
