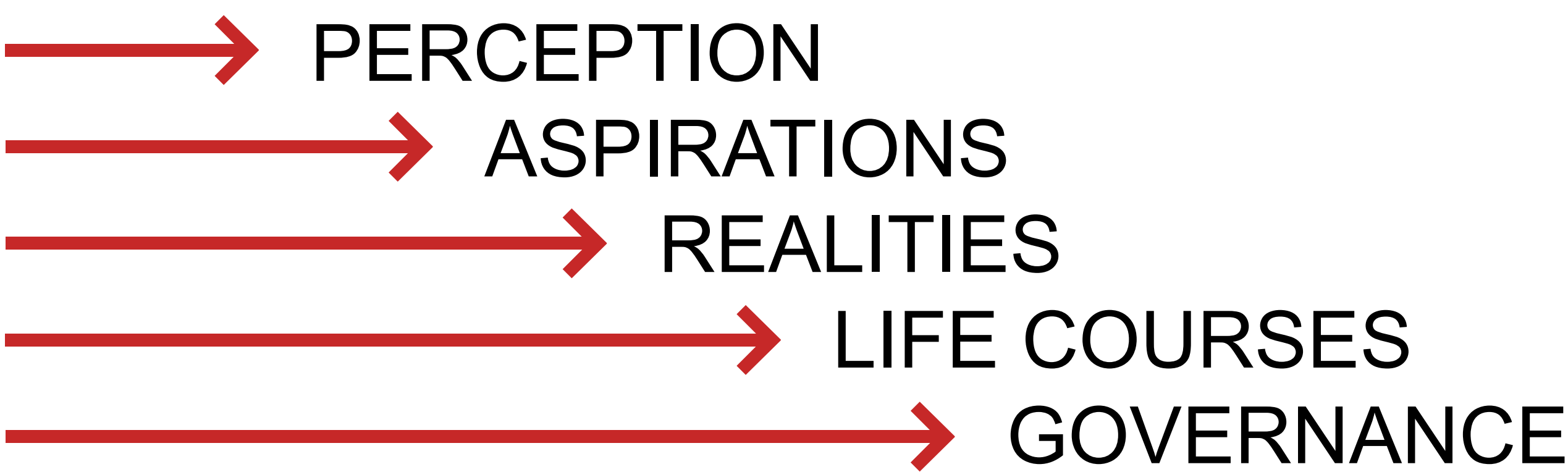


Crisis narratives shape migration
