Getting around Neuchâtel

Neuchâtel is relatively small and you can walk down easily from the train station to the conference venue and all social event locations (see general map attached and link further down). Just in case, public transportation is also available. For information:

The event will take place at the University of Neuchâtel, <u>Avenue du Premier-Mars 26 (**PM26** – in the following rooms (floor plans for PM26 on the following pages):</u>

PM26 – Ground and 1st: B29, B32, C46, C49, C56 (Sessions and Keynote). **2**nd **Floor**: D62, D63 and D71 (Extra rooms)

When you arrive, please begin by coming to the Welcome Desk (PM26 - Ground Floor) to pick up your badge. Luggage can be left at the Welcome Desk or in one of the classrooms (attended or locked during breaks). In any case, keep your valuables (wallet, passport etc) with you at all times. On day 2, luggage must be picked up at 16:45 (end of sessions).

WiFi

public-unine: network for guests, visitors and non-academic readers of the Public and University Library (BPU)

When logging in, a mobile phone number is required to which a code with limited validity is sent by SMS

- validity of the password once obtained: 1 hour
- session duration: 24 hours (or disconnection after 3 hours if there is no traffic)
- maximum 1 connected extension at a time per mobile phone number
- availability: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- speed per user: download 25Mbits/s and upload 2.5 Mbit/s
