This retreat is organized by the nccr – on the move in collaboration with the [Swiss Network for young Migration Scholars](#) (SNyMS). The retreat is open to members of the NCCR community, members of the SNyMS, and doctoral students enrolled in the CUSO program. It will take place at the Éco-Hôtel L'Aubier, in Montezillon, located in the beautiful countryside of the canton of Neuchâtel. The idea of the retreat is to offer the possibility to focus on an individual project and discuss it with a supportive and constructive community of other migration scholars.

Practical Information

The event is co-financed by the nccr – on the move and the SNyMS. Participants are asked to contribute to the costs by paying a **fee of CHF 150**. The price includes:

- Stay in an individual room at the Éco-Hôtel L'Aubier;
- Full pension (three breakfasts, four lunches, three dinners, six coffee breaks - three in the morning and three in the afternoon), starting with a lunch on Monday, the 23rd and ending with a lunch on Thursday, the 26th;
- Possibility to use a shared writing room with equipment (one flipchart and one projector).

The price does not include:

- Transport to and from the Éco-Hôtel l'Aubier;
- Anything ordered beyond the scope of the full pension (coffee, tea, snacks, etc.).
